GET ORGANISED AND READY TO MOVE HOME

Speak to your Conveyancer

Check your home insurance policy

Pack everything and label boxes

Have your mail forwarded

PREPARE TO LEAVE YOUR OLD HOUSE

Get in touch with your removal company

Speak to your Conveyancer

Get the essentials for moving day

Have your phone fully charged

Make sure you have all key documents

Walk around the house and do a final check

ON THE DAY OF YOUR MOVE

Greet your removal team

Make a note of your meter readings

Arrange drop-off and pick-up for your children and pets

Lock all windows and doors

SETTLE INTO YOUR NEW HOME

Check all the services are working and take meter readings

Ensure the removal company has done its job

Review your copy of the seller's fittings and contents form

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
